

Chili Cook-off Contestant Rules

- ◆ All chili entries must be made from scratch at home and brought to the church the day of the contest.
- ◆ One chili entry per contestant.
- ◆ All contestant chili entries must be delivered to the Fellowship Hall kitchen no later than (**March 14th @ 10:00 am**)
- ◆ Each contestant's chili container must have the **contestant's name** and be labeled "**Mild,**" "**Medium,**" "**Spicy**" or "**Hot-Hot**" attached to it.
- ◆ A long line Judging table(s) will be set up (smorgageboard style) in the Fellowship Hall with spaces provided for each chili entry sample cup, not in the original entrant's container.
- ◆ Each tasting station will have disposable spoons and a sample cup that will be identified with a contestant's number and temperature rating on a card: "**Mild,**" "**Medium,**" "**Spicy**" or "**Hot-Hot**"
- ◆ The name of the winner will be announced at the conclusion of the judging and after each contestant's voting cups money counted.
- ◆ The most money 'votes' collected by a contestant will win the contest.
- ◆ The winning entry will receive an award or certificate – first, second and third place, and have their picture taken with their award presentation.
- ◆ At the conclusion of the cook off, all the chili containers, crock pots etc., will be brought out onto a long table line and for a \$5.00 donation a bowl of one's favorite chili and a baked potato with all of the fixings will be provided for all. Note: Canning jars to be provided to take chili home for those wishing to donate a dollar (for the jar).
